



Budgetary Thrusts, Priorities and Strategies for FY 2023

Pursuant to RA 9729, as amended, and other climate change-related laws, the CCC is driven by the following thrusts, priorities, and strategies to navigate our country towards achieving a more sustainable, scientifically aligned transition to a new normal anchored on green recovery:

- a. Recommend/Formulate legislative proposals, policies, strategies, programs on and appropriations for climate change adaptation and mitigation and other related activities;
- b. Formulate and promulgate climate policies through Commission Resolutions, including input to vital policy documents related to climate change;
- c. Develop report on location-specific climate risk, and report on the adopted-enhanced Local Climate Change Action Plans;
- d. Develop national and domestic climate reports;
- e. Develop climate budget tagging-related reports based on reviewed climate budget and investments;
- f. Develop a comprehensive report on the scope, status including the inventory of outputs/ accomplishments and impacts of climate change-related projects;
- g. Implement and monitor the policies and measures under the Philippine's Nationally Determined Contribution (NDC);
- h. Pursue the completion of the green jobs certification standards and incentives system as a socio-economic and technological safeguard supporting just transition;
- i. Formulate Philippine Positions on climate change negotiation issues and decision areas in the international negotiation arena;
- j. Provide secretariat support to the Philippine Delegation to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change;
- k. Provide secretariat support to the Cabinet Cluster on Climate Change Adaptation, Mitigation and Disaster Risk Reduction;
- l. Provide secretariat support to the National Panel of Technical Experts;
- m. Mobilize People's Survival Fund for local climate adaptation solutions;
- n. Develop, produce, and disseminate knowledge and advocacy products and reports on climate change including information on impacts, adaptation needs, mitigation opportunities, climate finance, good practices, policies and measures, and researches, among others for various targeted audiences;
- o. Provide a platform for agencies and organizations to promote their various climate change adaptation and mitigation-related projects through forums, webinars and conferences;
- p. Encourage exchange of adaptation knowledge, experiences, and technologies through the production of adaptation tools and learning materials;
- q. Deliver various technical advisory support and capacity building initiatives geared towards enabling national government agencies and local government units to design and program climate change plans, activities, and programs;
- r. Monitor and evaluate the implementation of the National Climate Change Action Plan (NCCAP) 2017-2022; and
- s. Monitor the implementation of Executive Order No. 174, s. 2014 "Institutionalizing the Philippine Greenhouse Gas Inventory Management and Reporting System".
