



Budgetary Thrusts, Priorities and Strategies for FY 2021

Pursuant to the Republic Act No. 9729, as amended, as well as other climate change-related laws, and consistent with the Administration's Development Agenda, the CCC is driven by the following thrusts, priorities, and strategies to navigate our country towards achieving a more sustainable, scientifically-aligned transition to a new normal anchored on green recovery:

- a. Formulation and promulgation of climate policies through Commission resolutions (CCC);
- b. Updating of the National Climate Change Action Plan (NCCAP) and the National Strategic Framework on Climate Change (NFSCC);
- c. Provision of technical advisory support to the national government agencies on mainstreaming climate change adaptation and mitigation in policies, plans and programs;
- d. Participation of the Philippines in international climate diplomacy and negotiation processes of the UNFCCC;
- e. Conduct of advocacy for climate change policy leadership and action;
- f. Provision of technical and secretariat services to the Commission and associated bodies;
- g. Provision of support to operations of the National Designated Authority to the Green Climate Fund (GCF) and the Philippine membership in the GCF Board
- h. Conduct of climate science research studies;
- i. Conduct of policy reviews and roundtables on the thematic priorities of the NCCAP and the implementation of relevant laws;
- j. Conduct of a climate science research competition at the Climate Science Youth Congress;
- k. Coordination on NDC-related investment planning process;
- l. Establishment of climate risk transfer mechanism for local governments;
- m. Establishment of a knowledge and learning exchange platform, through the South-South Cooperation on Climate Information and Services Project;
- n. Conduct of the national stocktaking for the National Climate Risk Management Framework, in coordination with national government agencies concerned and partners;
- o. Production and dissemination of knowledge products and information-education-communication materials on climate change and related issues;
- p. Provision of training to local governments on the formulation and enhancement of Local Climate Change Action Plans, through the Communities for Resilience Program;
- q. Provision of training to farming and fishing communities on climate change adaptation and climate information services, through the Climate Resiliency Field School Program;
- r. Provision of annual orientation and training to national government agencies and local governments on climate budget tagging, through the Climate Change Expenditure Tagging Program;
- s. Conduct of technical evaluation and review of PSF project proposals for endorsement to the PSF Board;
- t. Provision of technical mentoring services to local governments and stakeholders on the development and enhancement of PSF project proposals;
- u. Coordination, formulation, and evaluation of funding proposals for GCF, GEF and other funding facilities;

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- v. Conduct of monitoring, evaluation, and reporting of the implementation of the NCCAP and NDC;
- w. Conduct of monitoring, evaluation, and reporting of progress on climate finance-funded and foreign-assisted projects on climate change adaptation and mitigation;
- x. Provision of analytics services on carbon footprint and GHG emissions to national and local government entities;
- y. Conduct of measurement, reporting, and verification (MRV) of greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions and reductions at national, sectoral, and local levels;
- z. Establishment of the standards and certification system for green jobs, pursuant to the Green Jobs Act of 2016;
- aa. Establishment of the quality assurance system for Local Climate Change Action Plans; and
- bb. Production of annual agency accomplishment report for Congress;
- cc. Production of periodic national climate change report for UNFCCC, National Communications Biennial Report
